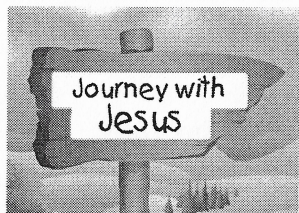

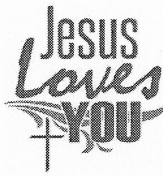

We Have Not Gone This Way Before

Within the last couple of days we know how things can become very uncertain very quick. In Joshua Chapter 3:3-5 we are reminded by Joshua on how to handle these uncertainties. "*And they commanded the people, saying, When ye see the ark of the covenant of the Lord your God, and the priests the Levites bearing it, then ye shall remove from your place, and go after it. [4] Yet there shall be a space between you and it, about two thousand cubits by measure: come not near unto it, that ye may know the way by which ye must go: for ye have not passed this way heretofore. [5] And Joshua said unto the people, Sanctify yourselves: for to morrow the Lord will do wonders among you.*"

Joshua knew that they have not passed this way before. Yet he knew that the first thing they needed to do when the Lord was ready for them to move, was to move. All they had to do was to trust and follow after Him. Secondly he also knew that they needed to be patient and give God space to work as He went before them. Often times we try to rush ahead of God instead of staying back and letting Him work. This does not mean that we don't move at all. We must learn to humble ourselves and follow at a distance so that we can see the path forward more clearly. The last thing he realized was that they needed to be reminded of who they were, a Nation that was to be set apart. We also need to be reminded of God's call upon our lives to be set apart and stay true to who we are as His children. As we look ahead to our uncertainties and knowing we have not been in this place before, may we understand that our Faith and our Hope is in the Lord. We also need to sanctify ourselves to make sure that our lives reflect who we are. May tomorrow the Lord do wonders among us.
